The Vitol Group of Companies is the largest independent, privately held oil trading, marketing and logistics company in the world. Vitol distributes and trades about 4.5 million barrels a day of crude oil and oil products worldwide and has become the largest spot charterer of oil tankers in the world. Revenues in 2006 exceeds 100 billion dollars. Vitol also trades sugar, chemicals, metals, metal concentrates and natural gas.

Vitol's assets are designed to support its trading business. It owns terminals in strategic areas of the world (Russia, Netherlands, Argentina, United Arab Emirates, China, India, etc), oil and exploration and production companies in Azerbaijan, Russia and Kazakhstan as well as west Africa, Indonesia and the Philippines.
